A CRITICAL MARINE HABITAT UNDER THREAT

Sigending, Berau, Indonesia, is a 500-hectare sanctuary that is vitally important as a feeding ground for green turtles, hawksbill turtles, manta rays, and saltwater crocodiles. It also serves as a migration route for turtles before they nest in the Derawan Archipelago. Most importantly, it is home to the endangered proboscis monkey.

WHAT'S HAPPENING?

- !! A recent slaughter of 10 green turtles was captured on video ([See the video](#) – viewer discretion is advised)
- 💔 Their bodies were mutilated: Organs and shells left behind
- 🥩 The meat was likely processed into illegal jerky and sold in Bontang.
- 👮 This is a direct violation of Indonesian Conservation Law (UU No. 5/1990).
